Resolution Agenda:

Adoption and institutionalisation of a comprehensive Membership Programme of the Soft Computing Research Society (SCRS).

Preamble:

In order to establish a structured, transparent, and sustainable framework for the admission, recognition, engagement, and governance of members, and to provide a uniform enabling mechanism for various categories of membership based on merit, experience, contribution, and distinction, the Governing Body of the Soft Computing Research Society (SCRS) considers it necessary to institute a consolidated Membership Programme of the Society.

Resolution:

On this day, 1st April, 2024, the Governing Body of the Soft Computing Research Society (SCRS) hereby resolves as follows:

1. Establishment of SCRS Membership Programme:

A comprehensive **Membership Programme of SCRS** is hereby instituted with effect from **1st April, 2024**, which shall serve as the principal and enabling framework governing all categories of membership of the Society.

2. Scope of the Membership Programme:

The Membership Programme shall provide for the creation, administration, and governance of **multiple categories of membership**, including but not limited to merit-based, experience-based, recognition-based, and honorary memberships, as may be introduced and approved by the Governing Body from time to time.

3. Category-wise Governance through Separate Resolutions:

Each category of membership under the Membership Programme shall be:

- Instituted through a **separate and specific resolution** of the Governing Body, and
- **Governed by its own independent and category-specific Bye-laws** which shall define defined provisions relating to eligibility, application or nomination process, evaluation mechanism, committee structure, fee framework, rights, privileges, and responsibilities.

Such category-specific resolutions shall be deemed to be issued pursuant to and in continuation of this Membership Programme, and shall form an integral part hereof.

4. Validation of Subsequent Membership Resolutions:

All membership-related resolutions passed on or after 1st April, 2024, including those establishing specific membership categories, shall be deemed to derive their authority from this Membership Programme and shall not be considered independent, inconsistent, or invalid merely on account of being issued separately or subsequently.

5. Authority of the Governing Body:

The Governing Body of SCRS shall have the exclusive authority to:

- Introduce, modify, expand, consolidate, suspend, or discontinue any category of membership;
- Constitute or reconstitute committees for evaluation, review, and administration of memberships;
- Prescribe operational guidelines, procedures, and formats for effective implementation of the Membership Programme.

6. Harmonious Interpretation:

This resolution and all category-specific membership resolutions shall be construed harmoniously with each other and with the Memorandum, Rules, and Regulations of the Society. In case of any ambiguity, the interpretation of the Governing Body shall be final and binding.

Implementation:

This resolution shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 2024, and shall operate as the parent, foundational, and enabling resolution for all existing and future membership categories of the Soft Computing Research Society.

Conclusion:

With the adoption of this Membership Programme, the Soft Computing Research Society reaffirms its commitment to institutional clarity, transparency, merit-based recognition, and the long-term strengthening of its academic and professional community.
